

"He isn't here! He is risen from the dead, just as he said would happen. Come, see where his body was lying." Matthew 28:6 NLT

I've tried to imagine what it must have been like for Mary Magdalene that morning as she went to the tomb. Were there tears in her eyes while she and the other Mary walked along the path, struggling with the memory of the crucifixion just two days before? Did she arrive at the tomb just in time to witness the angel rolling away the stone? Perhaps the tremors from the earthquake went unnoticed as she shook from fear at the sight, realizing Jesus was absent from the now-open tomb. Did she even notice the guards as they passed out from fright?

But then, the angel speaks to Mary and her companion, giving them a divine assignment: "...go quickly and tell his disciples that he has risen from the dead..." With the memory of the past Jesus had saved her from, the miraculous healing she'd received from the torment of demon possession, did Mary wonder why she of all people was chosen to carry the first message of the Savior's resurrection? Surely the angel knew that a woman wasn't considered to be a reliable witness in their Jewish culture. Shouldn't he have sent a couple of men with the message instead?

I have no way of knowing what thoughts actually swirled through Mary's mind that Easter morning, but I can just imagine her joy at meeting the newly risen Jesus along the road back to town. Nothing could keep her from running to Him and falling at his feet!

How beautiful the message for us all, that our Savior, Jesus Christ, died and rose again for every one of us. How precious the hope we all have because He didn't stay in that tomb. He is, and will always be, our risen Lord. Hallelujah!

Thank you, Jesus, for loving us so much that you died in our place, and that through your resurrection, we can live with you for all eternity. Amen.
